#### FOOD AND DRINK

We ask that if you send your child to school with a packed lunch that you involve him/her in making healthy choices. We are delighted to see that the vast majority of lunchboxes are already packed with healthy options which the children enjoy.

Some suggestions for a healthy lunchbox Sandwich/Wrap/Pasta Cubes of cheese/Sticks of carrot, cucumber etc Fruit Yogurt, Crisps (low salt, reduced fat options are best), Snack bar - a healthy option is good, Small piece of cake, bun, flapjack.

Please make sure that the children only put **water** in their water bottles, no juices please.
