It is really important that we adhere to the school uniform policy.

Accepted jewellery: watches, stud earrings (these must be covered for PE) no bracelets or necklaces accept for religious reasons. Please inform the class teacher via dojo for this. These must be removed for PE or when playing outside on any equipment.

- Grey trousers, pinafore dresses or shorts. (NOT BLACK)
- Black school shoes. (NOT trainers or boots. Only boots in Foundation stage). No flashing lights please.
- No bright bobbles, hairbands, just plain black/white
- Black, grey, white socks only please.

School Meals From the 1st of June we shall changing our school meal provider to Ideal School Meals.

Ideal School Meals are based in Sleaford and use local produce including, meat from Simpson's Butchers, fruit & vegetables sourced directly from Lincolnshire farms and bread from Bloomsbury Bakery. They offer 5 lunch options each day and are fully compliant with School Food Standards.

We are confident that this new partnership will enhance our lunchtime experience and provide the children with nutritious choice each day.
