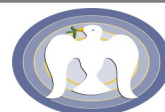
Enjoy the Easter break. We break up on Thursday 2nd April and return on Monday 20th April.

Our School is dedicated to supporting strong attendance for children so that they receive an excellent education and to support their wellbeing.

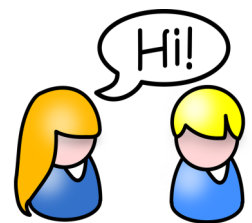
