They will be offering a wide range of instrumental and vocal sessions for our pupils. Guitar and Ukulele lessons will take place on Monday afternoons, singing sessions will run on Thursday afternoons, and Drum lessons will be available on Friday afternoons. We are also looking at an afterschool Music club. All Lincolnshire Music Service sessions will remain on the same days. These sessions give students the chance to develop their musical skills, build confidence, and explore new creative interests as part of their weekly school experience.

Move Up Morning

Move up day will be on Friday 26th June 2026. Your child will find out which class they are in and which teacher they will have in September. This is also when the Year 6 children go to their secondary schools for the day.

Ideal school meals - Menus went live on Monday 18th May ready for a 1st of June start.

- They use local produce, including meat from Simpson's Butchers, fruit and vegetables supplied by Jonathan Hull (sourced directly from Lincolnshire farms), and bread from Bloomsbury Bakery.
- They offer five lunch options each day, giving children much more choice at no additional cost. We have attached an example menu to give you an idea of what you can expect.
- Their kitchen is based in Sleaford - food that travels a shorter distance can be fresher, tastier, and more nutritious. There is also the added bonus of supporting local jobs and helping to reduce our carbon footprint.
